SleepOut 2018 Information

This information sheet is designed to give you an idea of what Doorway's SleepOut is about and what to expect if you choose to participate in the event.

SleepOut for Doorway

The SleepOut has been organised to coincide with Homeless Sunday on the 28th January, in order to increase awareness of homelessness in North Wiltshire and to raise much needed funds for the drop-in centre.

The event will take place in the churchyard of St Andrew's Church, Chippenham and will involve sleeping rough with only minimal protection from the winter weather. It is your responsibility to provide warm clothing, sleeping bag etc for you and any children under 18 for whom you are responsible – see check list overleaf

Date and time

The SleepOut starts at **7pm on Saturday 27th January 2018** and carries on through the night until **7am** the following morning. You may leave the site at any time but we would appreciate it if you could try and stay on the site all night. Please notify the person in charge if you intend to leave the venue. Remember that there will be no public transport available. Ensure that you have made suitable arrangements to get home in the morning, bearing in mind you may be cold and tired.

There will be no Church service this year due to renovation works at the premises.

The bedtime story will be read by Marc Allum at 11pm.

Children

We welcome children to participate, however for health and safety reasons, all participants under 18 years old must ensure that they are accompanied by a responsible adult who is at least 18 years old. Minimum age is 10 years old.

Please ensure that a separate registration form is filled in for each child with the relevant information giving consent etc. Doorway Wiltshire Ltd will not be held responsible for the safety of participants since we will be holding the event in a public place.

Facilities

Toilet facilities will be provided in the Church throughout the night.

Hot drinks will be provided between the hours of 6pm and 11pm; and between 6am and 7am.

Registration

You must ensure that you have registered before the event with the official registration form. On the night you must bring with you the completed forms for yourself and for each child under 18 for whom you are taking responsibility.

The registration point will be open from **6pm until 10pm.**

On arrival at the site please sign in at the registration desk inside St Andrew's Church to ensure that we are aware that you are on site. You will then receive a proof of your attendance.

Money and sponsorship

There is no charge to participate in the SleepOut but we do ask that you raise money for Doorway by getting sponsored to sleep rough for the night.

Doorway is a charity and therefore relies on donations to continue to make a difference to the lives of many homeless people by providing them with a hope for the future.

We would prefer that you collected sponsorship money through our account with VirginMoneyGiving since this reduces the amount of office admin work. Gift aid will automatically be claimed on our behalf. Further details will be available in your pack.

If you are unable to donate online then there will be a sponsor form in your pack. Please make cheques payable to 'Doorway Wiltshire' and post to the address below.

Before the night

Please remember that we will be sleeping outside during the night in January and that the weather will be very cold, so ensure that you are prepared physically and mentally. Use the check list below as a guide to what you will need to bring with you in order to protect you from the worst of our winter weather.

Your clothing should be warm and waterproof – several thin layers of clothing are better than one thick layer. A woolly hat, warm footwear and gloves and a sleeping bag will be essential.

It is highly recommended that you bring a large cardboard box as protection from the wind, preferably large enough to actually sleep inside.

Check list for the night - (optional but recommended!)

- Sleeping bag
- Plastic groundsheet
- Thick newspaper or insulated mat
- Cardboard box
- Blanket
- Medication
- Black bin bag for rubbish
- Warm clothes
- Hat
- Gloves
- Torch

Important notes

Participants take part in the SleepOut at their own risk:- Doorway will not be held responsible for loss or damage to personal effects, for personal accidents, for injury or loss to third parties.

No non-prescription or illegal drugs are allowed on the site:- If you are caught then you will be asked to leave and the police will be informed.

The churchyard is part of the town alcohol-free zone therefore we request no alcohol to be brought onto the site.

The site must be vacated at 7am. Please ensure that you remove all belongings and rubbish including cardboard boxes.

Thank you for supporting Doorway and please spread the word.

Whilst we will not be able to replicate the realities of sleeping rough we can increase awareness within our local community.

**Remember that although we are giving up a warm bed for the night,
we still have one to go back home to in the morning...**
